2. Please use only soft pencil for marking the parts. A charge will be made for any missing or defaced material (marking in Biro, coloured pencil or obliterations or text or music). This will be taken from the deposit.
3. Material is to be returned, carefully packed, complete and in the condition supplied, at the Hirer's expense, within 7 days of the last performance.
4. The use of the Pattersong Music arrangements must be credited in the show programme. Please use the following words:  
"Orchestral arrangement supplied by Martin Paterson of Pattersong Music. For more information about this and other similar G&S arrangements see [www.pattersong.co.uk](http://www.pattersong.co.uk)."
5. The Hirer will include a copy of the programme when returning the materials.
6. The unauthorised copying of the material in whole or in part by any method (e.g. photocopying) is illegal and constitutes an infringement of copyright.
7. The Hirer may record one or more of the performances either on video or audio, for non-commercial use only i.e. distribution to cast and friends and family. If such a recording is made a copy in each media produced must be sent to Pattersong Music. If the cover of the recording contains the names of the players in the band or the name of the group from which they come then this must be accompanied with the same words as for the programme in §4 above.
8. The arrangement must be played by the all instrumentalists specified.
9. A cancellation fee will be charged for materials sent and not used.
10. The invoice must be paid in full before the materials can be shipped.
